



Hey Folks, thanks for your interest at Habitat.

We get many bands/performers that want to play Habitat, but it's just not possible to accommodate everyone who sends in requests. It is possible your request may be rejected, not because we don't want you to play here, but because we have limited bookings available and we receive a high volume of requests.

When is the last time you recall spending your hard earned money to see a show? It was most likely because it was something you had seen on television, heard on the radio, or was dragged to by your die-hard fan friends. So basically if you are an unknown act, chances are that people aren't going to show up just because you're playing... even at the hottest venues

Typically, the band makes no money if no one shows up. Actually, no one makes any money. If that keeps happening the venue eventually closes its doors, which means one less live venue for bands to play at. Please keep this in mind when sending in your request forms, and allow for a minimum of four weeks for proper promotion.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

First off, refer to the "Book an Event" page on our web site: <http://thehabitat.ca>, and submit the booking request. You may call our office between 11am—5pm from Tuesdays to Thursday to inquire as to the status of your request. However, please keep in mind that we do not book over the phone, and harassment will result in the rejection of your request to play at Habitat. SUCCESS

First you will be contact by a Habitat show rep, who will confirm the details of the booking with you or your agent/group. Now that you've been booked it's your job to ensure a good turnout. Call the radio, send us press kits and get online a contact our local event listings to support the show. As of August 16, 2011 our capacity is 225 people and we are a 19+ venue. It's important that you aim for reach these numbers if you want to make the show a success. A good turn out makes everyone happy. Happy people re-book you.

POSTER LAW

We understand you're a star Photoshop master and your posters are a masterful piece of art... but ALL POSTERS MUST BE APPROVED BY HABITAT. Helpful hints include: make sure our logo is properly displayed, the address is correct, and your art is tasteful.
